THE KURT GRUNWALD COLLECTION – P 77

Kurt Grunwald was the son of Rabbi Max Grunwald¹. Born in Vienna in 1901, he settled with his parents in Jerusalem in 1938 and served as a banker, economist and public figure in Jerusalem. Kurt Grunwald wrote on various aspects of Jewish economic history, notably *Türkenhirsch* (1966), a study of Baron Maurice (Moritz) de Hirsch.
